School Transport

Home to school transport for children who are about to transition into secondary school are to apply for School Transport before 31 May 2024 deadline. Applications made after this deadline could result in a long delay of being informed of the outcome of your application and potentially if pupils are entitled transport it may not be in place for September, and it would then be the responsibility of the parent/carers to transport the pupil to and from school in the interim period.

When an application is made and assessed parents will receive an update email with a link to their Citizen Portal message area, and if the child qualifies for Home to School Transport a pass will be sent before the end of August.


