Now you understand the problem and the solution.

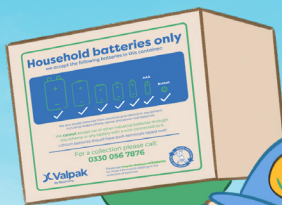
Let's help Superewe to start a baa-ttery recycling revolution!
