### **Mini Medics – FINAL CHANCE TO REGISTER YOUR INTEREST**

On Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> November SLP First aid will be delivering the mini medics programme to the KS2 children. After the session, if there is enough uptake SLP first aid would deliver a Paediatric 1 hour 30-minute session to parents and the community from 3.30pm – 5pm. This session would cover:

- DR ABC- Primary assessment of the casualty
- Recovery position- Safe airway position for both adults and children
- CPR and Defibrillator- A practical session using adult, junior and baby manikins and a demonstration of the Defibrillator
- Choking- Adult and child protocols, using choke vests to practice

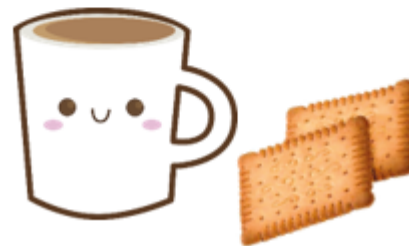
