KS2 Mountain Biking at Whinlatter Forest – TOMORROW

As part of the P.E. Outdoor Adventurous Activity Curriculum the school has organised three half day mountain biking sessions at Whinlatter. Children will be visiting Whinlatter on Wednesday 7th & 21st May and 4th June. These will be run by a qualified British Cycling MTB guide and tailored to the children's skill level. All equipment will be provided. **(Depending on the weather your child will need to wear shorts or tracksuit bottoms and t-shirt/top and waterproof jacket.)** If your child usually has a school meal a packed lunch will be provided. Children will be transported to Whinlatter Forest by Telford's coaches leaving at 9am returning back to school for 3.30pm.

KS2 Hadrian's Wall Walk

We are excited to offer our KS2 students a unique and enriching opportunity to bring their history learning to life with a walking and camping trip to study the Romans and Hadrian's Wall.

This experience will combine physical activity, teamwork, and outdoor education with a deep dive into the history of Roman Britain.

Trip Overview:

- Wednesday, 19th June 2025 – First guided day walk along part of Hadrian's Wall, focusing on Roman history, landmarks, and geography.
- Thursday, 3rd July to Friday, 4th July 2025 – Two-day walking trip, including one-night camping. The walk will continue along Hadrian's Wall, with activities such as site exploration, Roman-themed challenges, and group discussions.

Purpose of the Trip:

- Deepen understanding of the Romans in Britain and the significance of Hadrian's Wall
- Develop map-reading and navigation skills
- Promote teamwork, independence, and resilience
- Experience outdoor learning in a fun and engaging way
