With the help of their friendly mascot Buddy, they’ll be presenting an assembly to the children in our school as well as a workshop for Years 5 and 6.

What is the *Speak out. Stay safe.* programme?

Through child-friendly, interactive assemblies and workshops the specially trained staff give our children information about how to keep themselves safe from harm and how to get help if they have any worries, sensitively discussing issues like bullying and sexual abuse, without using scary words or adult language. The content of the assemblies and workshops are totally age appropriate and by the end of the visit the children will know how they can speak out and stay safe.
